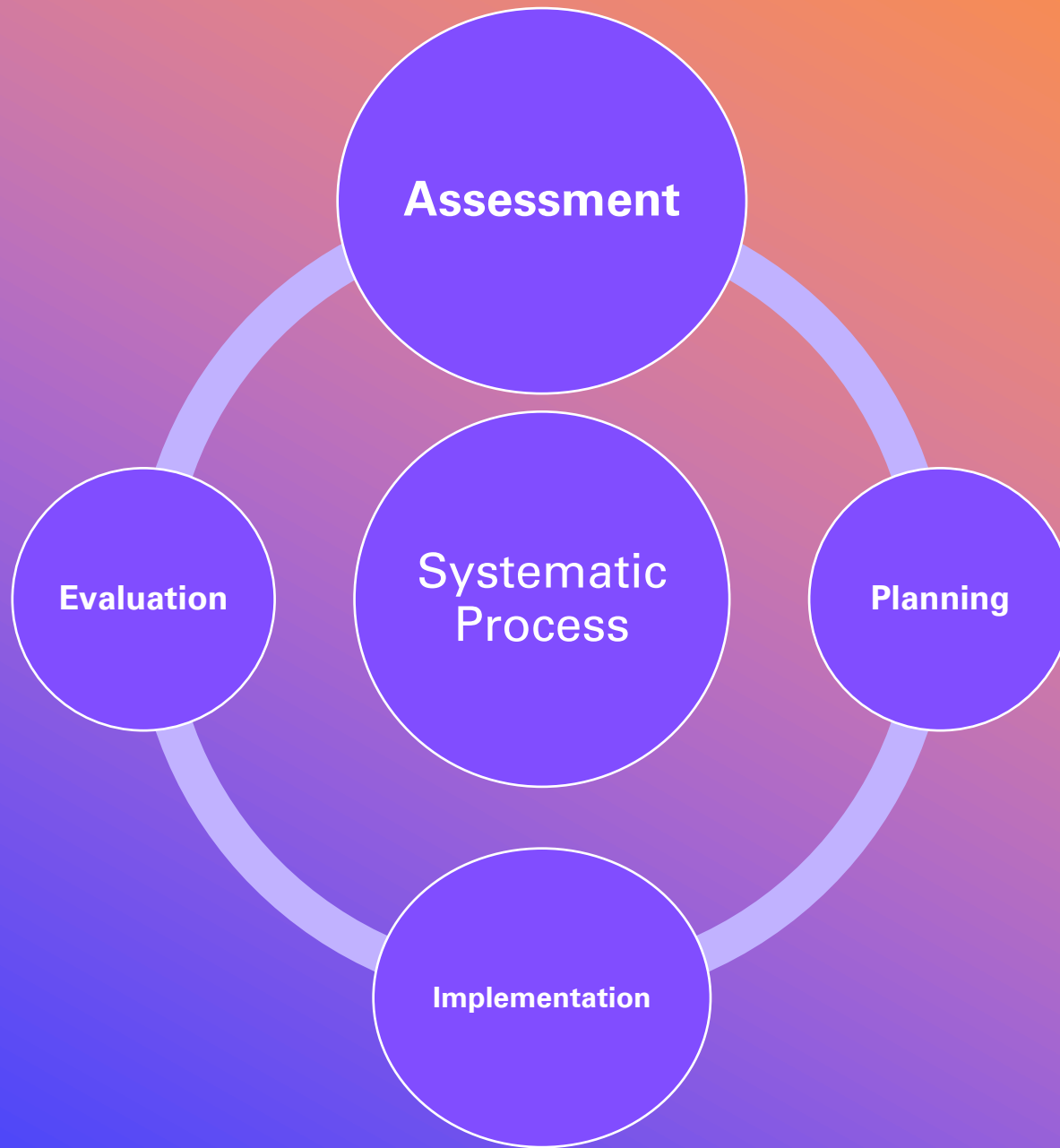
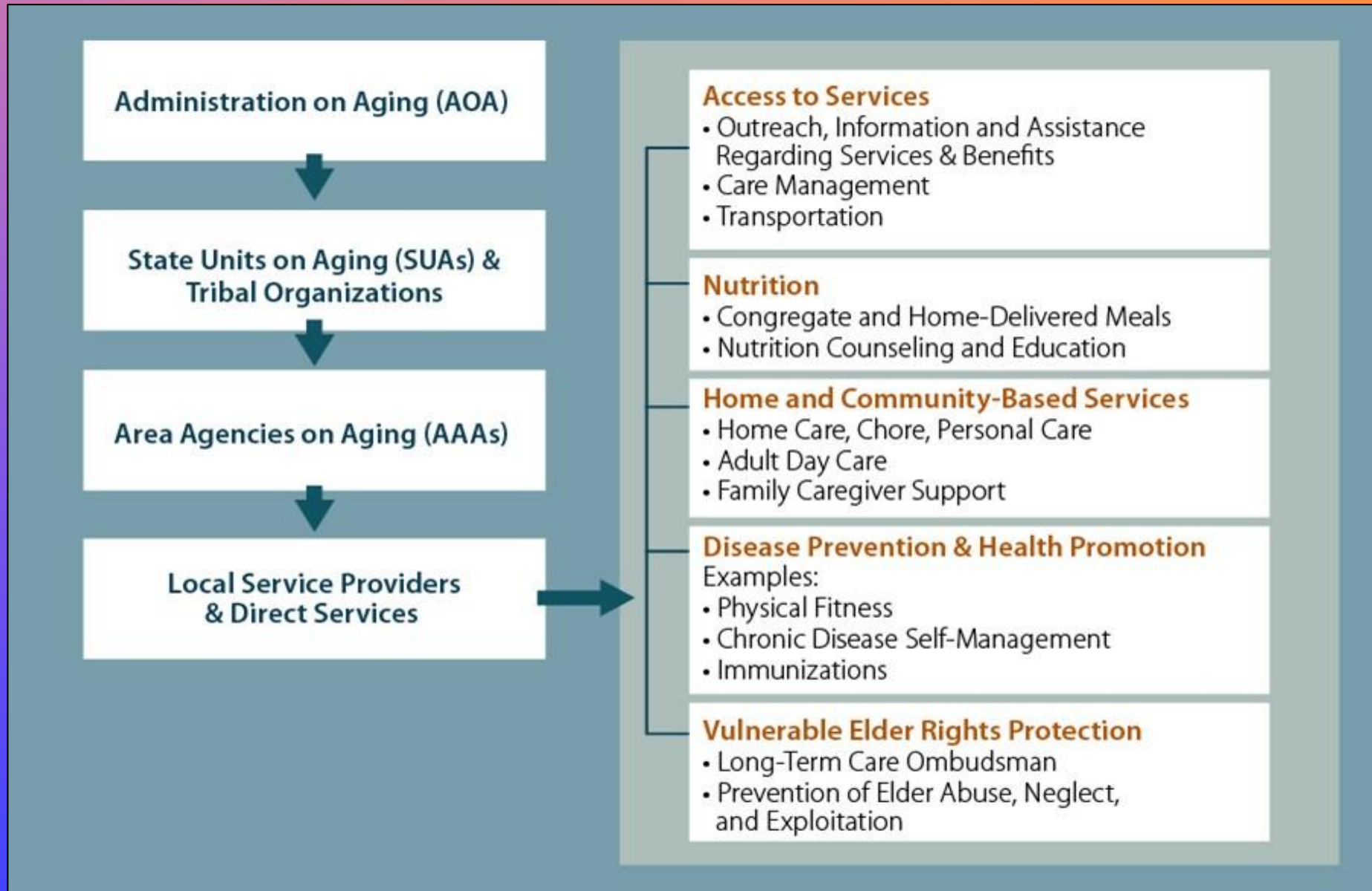


Figure 1 . The Aging Network

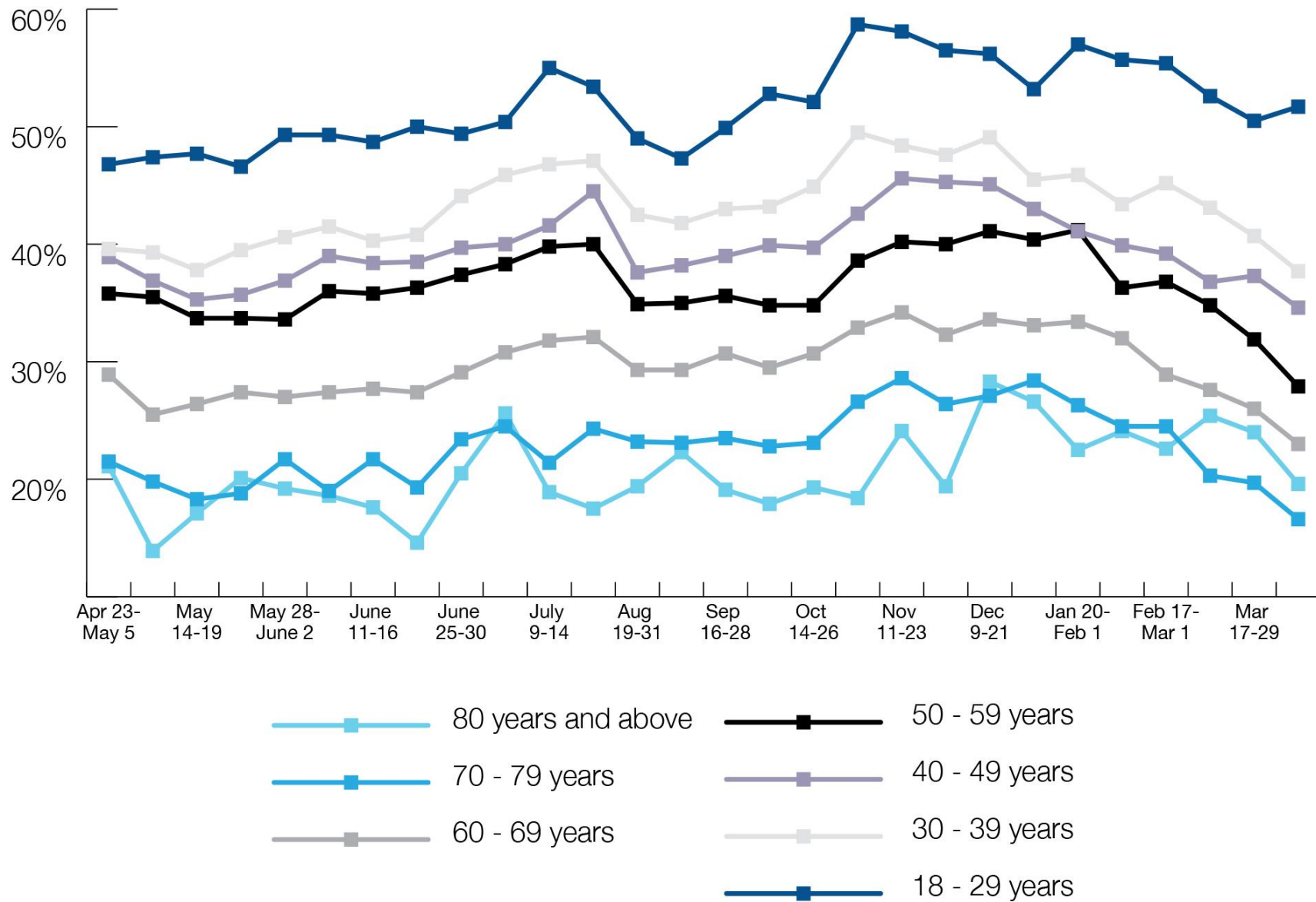

PA State Plan on Aging

- **Top six factors rated “absolutely critical” for ensuring age-friendly communities over the next 5 years:**
 - Affordable prescription medications (67.9%)
 - Access to in-home care and services (51%)
 - Available/affordable housing (45.6%)
 - Available/affordable transportation (43%)
 - Dementia-capable/dementia-friendly communities (40.5%)
 - Access to mental health services (40.2%)
- Innovations to meet our needs in next 10 years and beyond: universal access to technology/broadband, education on technology & innovative housing themes
